## Assemble Piping On A Round Bottom

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## Instructions:


1. Cut off a 4 cm (1-1/2") from your piping cord strip, place on the bottom piece, right side down.



2. Take your piping cord strip and centre your piping cord inside, fold the strip towards the edge of your bottom piece to enclose the piping cord, clip or pin in place.



**3.** You may need to make some notches in the curved parts to facilitate molding.





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4. When you get back to the beginning, cut your piping cord so that it butts up snuggly against the beginning of your cord.


Fold over the 4 cm (1- 1/2") strip to encase

and hide the join.





**6.** Sew around the bottom to secure the piping cord using a piping foot or zipper foot.





Congratulations, your Bottom is complete!
